Objectives of the Cell:-

The major objectives of the Career Counselling, Placement Cell, and Personal Counselling Cell include:

To provide structured career guidance and counselling to students for better decision-making, enhance students' employability skills such as communication, soft skills, interview techniques, and personality development. create awareness about job opportunities, competitive exams, and entrepreneurship. Activities Conducted (Session 2025–2026):-

❖ PM Yuva Rozgar Yojana Awareness and Training Program (18 August 2025 – 31 January 2026):-

Under the Pradhan Mantri Yuva Rozgar Yojana (PMVRY), a comprehensive awareness and training initiative was conducted over an extended period. The primary aim of this program was to encourage students towards self-employment and entrepreneurship by informing them about government schemes, financial assistance, and startup opportunities. During the program, students were guided about business planning, financial literacy, and skill-based employment opportunities. Special emphasis was laid on motivating female students to become financially independent and self-reliant. This initiative helped students understand practical aspects of entrepreneurship.

❖ One-Day Workshop on “Interview Skills” (8 October 2025):-

The Career Counselling and Placement Cell organized a one-day workshop on “Interview Skills” to prepare students for real-world job selection processes. Around 71 students participated enthusiastically in the session. The workshop covered important aspects such as resume building, body language, communication techniques, and handling interview questions effectively. Mock interview sessions were also conducted to give students practical exposure.

❖ **Workshop on “Entrepreneurship & Innovation as a Career Opportunity” (18 November 2025):-**

One-day workshop was organized on the topic “Entrepreneurship & Innovation as a Career Opportunity.” Around 76 students actively participated in this interactive session. The workshop emphasized the importance of innovation, creativity, and problem-solving skills in today’s dynamic world. Students were encouraged to think beyond conventional career choices and explore startup culture. Real-life examples, success stories, and interactive discussions inspired students to develop an entrepreneurial.

❖ **One-Day Workshop on “Career Counselling for Employability” (12 February 2026):-**

A one-day workshop was jointly organized by the Hindi Department and the Career Counselling & Placement Cell on the topic “Career Counselling for Employability.” The program witnessed the active participation of approximately 160 students, making it one of the most impactful sessions of the session. The workshop focused on enhancing employability skills, career planning, and understanding the expectations of employers. Students were guided on how to align their academic knowledge with practical skills required in the job market. The session also highlighted the importance of continuous learning, adaptability, and professional ethics. It proved to be highly beneficial in preparing students for future career challenges.

❖ **Two-Day Career Training cum Placement Drive (13–14 February 2026):-**

A two-day Career Training cum Placement Drive was organized by the Career Counselling, Placement Cell, and Personal Counselling Cell in collaboration with AWL Metaverse Pvt. Ltd. and Navchetna Pharmaceuticals Pvt. Ltd. The program was designed to provide students with practical exposure to the recruitment process and direct interaction with industry professionals.

On 13 February 2026, approximately 250 students registered for the placement drive by filling out a Google Form, reflecting a high level of enthusiasm and participation. On the same day, a written examination was conducted in which 90 students appeared. Out of these, 45 students successfully qualified for the next stage of the selection process based on their performance.

On 14 February 2026, the shortlisted candidates were invited for the interview round, where they were assessed on their communication skills, subject knowledge, confidence, and overall personality. After a rigorous evaluation process, 20 students successfully cleared the interview round. Based on their performance in both the written examination and interview, these 20 students were selected for job opportunities, and appointment letters were issued to them by the collaborating companies.

The moment of selection brought immense joy and enthusiasm among the students, and their excitement after receiving the job offers was truly remarkable.
