**Event: Anti-Drug Awareness Programme under 'Nasha Mukh Bharat**  
**Abhiyan' on the occasion of 'World Health Day' through a 'Nukkad**  
**Natak' titled 'Safed Sona Ya Zehar?'**

On 7<sup>th</sup> April, 2026, on the occasion of 'World Health Day' a well-organized and impactful Awareness Programme was conducted. The programme was organized under the joint aegis of the Anti-Drug Awareness Cell and Youth Red Cross of the college, in accordance with the directions of Director General Higher Education, Panchkula and under the 'Nasha Mukh Bharat Abhiyan'. On this occasion, a powerful street play titled "Safed Sona Ya Zehar" was presented in which 9 students played the main roles, while a total of 110 students actively participated in the programme. The play was staged at 10:00 a.m. near Ram Mandir, Rani Talab in the presence of a significant gathering of local residents. Through the street play "Safed Sona Ya Zehar", the students effectively demonstrated, through impactful and emotionally engaging performances, that substances often referred to as "white gold" are in reality deadly poison that gradually destroys an individual's physical, mental and social well-being. The narrative of the play portrayed how young individuals, driven by curiosity, peer pressure and the desire for enjoyment, initially experiment with drugs, which eventually leads to addiction and devastation. Through strong dialogues, expressions and stage presentation, the students highlighted that drug abuse not only affects an individual's health but also disrupts family structures and social harmony. The climax of the play depicted the tragic death of a young individual due to drug addiction, leaving the family in deep distress, thereby creating a profound emotional impact on the audience and compelling them to reflect on the grave consequences of substance abuse. The play concluded with a collective anti-drug pledge, wherein the assembled crowd, students and thousands of spectators took an oath together against drug abuse, reinforcing a strong commitment towards a

drug-free society. The programme commenced at 9:45 a.m. with the assembly of students in the college premises. On this occasion, the Principal, Dr. Poonam Mor motivated the students to actively participate in the fight against drug abuse and extended her best wishes for their efforts. Thereafter, the students proceeded to the venue, where they initiated the programme with an awareness song, followed by the impactful presentation of the street play. The programme received significant support from the Police Narcotics Department, with the presence of SI Naresh Kumar (Incharge, Nasha Mukti Team), SI Balbir Singh, Lady Constable Kavita. Additionally, faculty members Dr. Pinki, Mrs. Ranjana, Mrs. Rekha, Dr. Niketa, Dr. Tanu, Mrs. Shivani, Miss Surbhi, Mr. Jasbir Kajal, Mr. Parveen, Mr. Narayan, Mr. Vikas, Mrs. Usha and Mrs. Sheelwanti were also present and contributed actively to the success of the programme. On this occasion, SHO City Mr. Dinesh Kumar highly appreciated the students' presentation of the street play and stated that the students of Hindu Kanya Mahavidyalaya had conveyed a strong and meaningful message against drug abuse through their performance. He further remarked that such creative initiatives not only guide the youth in the right direction but also serve as an important step toward building a healthy, aware and empowered society. The programme was efficiently conducted by Dr. Seema Dalal. At the conclusion of the event, an awareness rally was organized with the joint participation of the students and the Narcotics Department. The rally commenced from the venue of the play and concluded at the college campus. During the rally, students raised impactful slogans against drug abuse, spreading awareness among the public. Upon reaching the college, the Principal, Dr. Poonam Mor welcomed all participants and appreciated their commendable efforts. She also acknowledged the contributions of the staff and the Narcotics Department and encouraged the students to continue participating actively in such socially relevant initiatives in the future. NSS volunteers and NCC cadets also participated enthusiastically, demonstrating discipline, dedication and social responsibility.

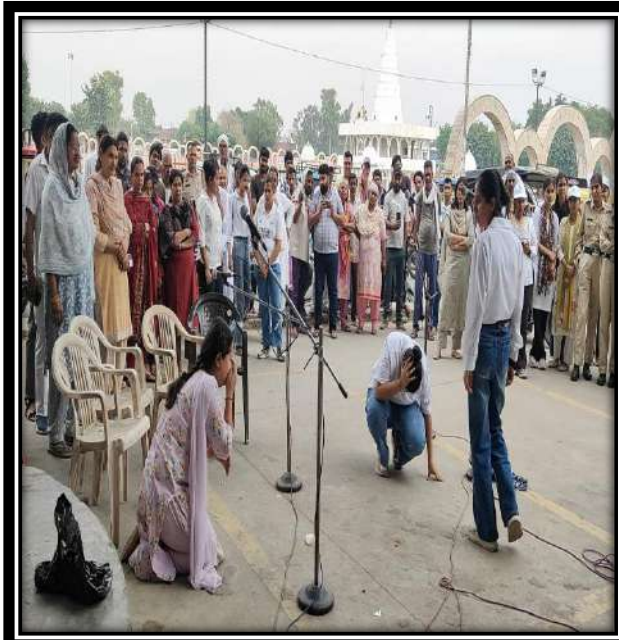
