

# **ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEVELOPMENT CELL**

## **(Annual Report 2025-26)**

Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC) was established in order to identify and groom prospective entrepreneurs among students. The objective of this cell is to inculcate the spirit of entrepreneurship among students and motivate them to start their own ventures/Start Ups instead of queuing up in the job market. A number of activities were organized in 2025 to promote entrepreneurial awareness, creativity, and skill development among students.

A **Workshop on Entrepreneurship & Innovation as a Career Opportunity** on **21 August 2025**, organized on the occasion of World Entrepreneurship Day. The workshop motivated students to consider entrepreneurship as a career and highlighted the role of innovation in business success.

This was followed by a **Poster Making Competition** on **26 August 2025**, based on the theme of entrepreneurship. The competition encouraged students to creatively present their ideas and understanding of entrepreneurial concepts.

On **9 October 2025**, a **Mehandi Program** was conducted under the initiative “*Earn While You Learn*” on the occasion of Karva Chauth. This activity provided practical exposure to income-generating skills and promoted self-reliance among students.

A **Virtual Invited Talk on Skills for Entrepreneurs** was held on **4 November 2025**, where students gained insights into essential entrepreneurial skills such as communication, leadership, and decision-making.

Further, an **Awareness Programme on Entrepreneurship** was organized on **10 November 2025** on the occasion of National Entrepreneurship Day. The programme aimed to spread awareness about entrepreneurship and encourage students to explore startup opportunities.
