- Slogan Writing Competition** was organised on 8<sup>th</sup> September, 2023 on the theme “**Save Environment Save Nation.**” This competition aimed to raise awareness among students about pressing issues such as Global Warming, Climate Change, and Deforestation, which can hamper the economic development of our nation. Fourteen students competed by crafting thought-provoking and impactful slogans related to the theme.
- Poster Making Competition** was organised on 8<sup>th</sup> September, 2023 on the theme “**Save Environment Save Nation.**” Thirteen students participated in the competition, showcasing their creative skills and conveying powerful messages through their artwork. The posters

served as a visual medium to highlight the urgency of environmental conservation and its direct impact on the nation's progress.

3. **Quiz Competition** was organized under the Talent Search Programme on 27<sup>th</sup> September 2023 for first year students. Students from various departments of Arts, Science and Commerce participated in the competition. The objective of this event was to improve the general knowledge of students.
4. **Video Presentation Competition** was organized on 4<sup>th</sup> October, 2023 in collaboration with NCC to celebrate International Day of **Non-Violence**. Twelve students from different classes participated in the competition, demonstrating their creative skills and illustrating powerful messages through their artwork. The aim of the competition was to promote the message of non-violence among the students.
5. **Two-days Training Programme** on the theme “**Financial Education for Young Citizens**” was organized from 5<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> October 2023 in collaboration with Kotak Securities, a CSR initiative of Kotak Securities. The training programme was conducted by the National Institute of Securities Market (NISM), the leading institute for securities market education in India. During the two-days training programme, Mr. Ramphal Punia covered various concepts, including types of investments, financial opportunities in small-saving schemes such as PPF, National Savings Certificate, and Sukanya Samriddhi Yojana etc.
6. **One-day workshop** on “**Research Methodology**” was organized on 7<sup>th</sup> October, 2023. The objective of this workshop was to develop research culture among students. Professor S. K. Sinha, Dean Academic Affairs and Chairperson, Department of Management & Commerce Chaudhary Ranbir Singh University, Jind acted as a resource person in the first session of the workshop and Dr. Rachna Shrivastava, Assistant Professor of Management, Chaudhary Ranbir Singh University, Jind expressed her views on Research Methodology in the second session of workshop. Seventy-six students actively participated in the workshop and gained valuable insights on Research Methodology.

- 7. An Awareness Rally** was taken out in Buren village (Pillukhera) on the topic “**Fight against Population Explosion**” on 24<sup>th</sup> November 2023. The primary objective of this rally was to raise awareness among the masses about the consequences of unchecked population growth along with remedial measures through slogans like 'Small family, happy family', Control Overpopulation remain away from starvation', Plan your family and protect the Planet' etc. Thirty- three students participated in this rally.
- 8. Entrepreneurship Development Programme** in collaboration with Swavalambi Bharat Abhiyan, Haryana was organized on 25<sup>th</sup> November 2023. The primary objective of this programme was to foster the spirit of entrepreneurship among students. Mr. Kapil Madan, the State Coordinator of Swavalambi Bharat Abhiyan, Haryana, graciously acted as the resource person for the event and enlightened the one hundred and two attendees about the initiative. Mr. Madan provided detailed information about Swavalambi Bharat Abhiyan (SBA) and said that the core objective of this initiative is to create awareness among individuals about start-ups, entrepreneurship, and employment opportunities. The main aim is to ensure job creation for every Indian citizen by 2030, promoting self-sufficiency and independence for the nation.
- 9. An Awareness Programme on “Entrepreneurship Development”** under the aegis of Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, Government of India was organized on 28<sup>th</sup> November 2023. Ms. Rachna Tripathi, IEDS, Assistant Director, MSME Branch, Bhiwani, graciously acted as keynote speaker and Mr. Umesh, Senior Engineer, MSME TC Rohtak and Ms. Chetna, Industrial Extension Officer, District MSME Centre, Jind acted as resource persons in this Awareness Programme on Entrepreneurship Development. The objective of this Programme was to aware students about self-employment avenues, to foster the spirit of entrepreneurship among them and aware them about the various schemes of MSME Govt. of India. One hundred and three students participated in this awareness program.

**10. Two days Faculty Development Programme on “Macro Management and Time Management”** was on 13<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> January 2024. The session aimed to provide valuable insights into the concept of macro management leadership and time management. Dr. Upasana, an esteemed resource person and Associate Professor in Commerce at H.K.M.V., Jind, took charge of the session. With great expertise, she delivered a comprehensive explanation of the concept of macro management leadership, emphasizing its significance in fostering a laissez-faire leadership style. Through suitable examples, she shed light on the aspects of providing control and autonomy to employees over their work along with the concept of time management and its strategies. All the teaching and non-teaching staff members actively participated in the Faculty Development Programme.

**11. Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on the topic “MOODLE (LMS)”** was organized on 10<sup>th</sup> February, 2024. During the event, Mrs. Shivani, Assistant Professor in Computer Science at H.K.M.V., Jind, delivered a comprehensive explanation of the MOODLE e-learning platform. Subsequently, Dr. Priyanka Sahni, provided detailed information on additional MOODLE modules. She covered topics such as creating discussion forums, uploading assignments, quizzes, and more on the LMS. Thirty-five faculty members participated in this Faculty Development Programme.

**12. Guest lecture on the topic entitled “Shape your future with Economics”** was organized on 6<sup>th</sup> March, 2024. Dr. Poonam, an alumna of the college and currently an Assistant Professor in Economics Department at M.D. University, Rohtak, shared insights on various job options available after completion of graduation and post-graduation in Economics. Fifty-one students from the Economics Department attended the guest lecture, showing their interest in exploring career possibilities within the field of Economics.

**13. Storypreneur-Article Writing Competition** was organized from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> March, 2024 and result of the event was declared on 7<sup>th</sup> March, 2024. The objective of this competition was to inspire the students to pursue entrepreneurship by learning about the success journey of

entrepreneurs through their life stories. Eighteen students from different classes participated in the competition.

**14. One-day workshop on “Basics of Research Methodology and Statistical Analysis using SPSS”** was organized on 12<sup>th</sup> March, 2024. Dr. Suraj Walia, Head, Department of Economics, R. K. S. D. College, Kaithal acted as a key note speaker in the first session of the workshop and the topic of his discussion was ‘Basics of Research Methodology’. Dr. Suraj emphasized the need for outcome-based research in India, which means the research should have practical implications and contribute to the development of society. In the second session, Dr. Ritu Walia acted as a resource person and the topic of her discussion was 'Statistical analysis using SPSS'. She gave a demonstration of all statistical tools in SPSS. she told students about how to import data file in SPSS, how to analyse the data along-with the interpretation of statistical results. Eighty students participated in this workshop.

**15. One-day Multidisciplinary National Seminar (Online) on the topic “Entrepreneurial India: A Fascinating Vision”** was organized approved by D.G.H.E., Haryana on 29<sup>th</sup> March, 2024 in which 169 participants from different states actively participated in this seminar and present their research ideas in seven parallel technical sessions. During the **Inaugural session** of the seminar, Dr. Sunil Shukla, Director of Indian Entrepreneurship Development Institute, Ahmedabad was the keynote speaker of the seminar, who discussed in detail about running entrepreneurship development programs in underdeveloped states. Professor Neera Verma from the Department of Economics, Gurugram University, Gurugram shared her views as the chief guest and Professor S. K. Sinha from Chaudhary Ranbir Singh University, Jind as a guest of honour expressed his views. In the **plenary session**, the first resource person was Dr. Manmeet Kukreja from Mittal School of Business, Lovely Professional University, Jalandhar, Punjab, Professor Ritu Narang, from the Department of Business Administration, Lucknow University. Dr. Simi Vashishtha from School of Allied Health Sciences and Management, Delhi Pharmaceutical Sciences and Research University, New Delhi addressed the

participants as the resource persons. Dr. Rashi Taggar from School of Business, Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University, Jammu and Kashmir acted as a resource person in the **Valedictory session.**

**16. One-day workshop** on the topic entitled on “**Intellectual Property Rights**” was organized on 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2024. In the first session of workshop, Dr. Supreet Gill, Assistant Professor from the University Institute of Legal Studies, Panjab University, Chandigarh, shared insights on Intellectual Property Rights. Her topic of Presentation was IPR- Copyright and Trademark. Ms. Kritika Sheoran, Assistant Professor at University Institute of Legal Studies, Panjab University, Chandigarh, led the second session on Patents and Industrial designs within Intellectual Property Rights. Fifty students actively participated in the workshop, gaining valuable insights into Intellectual Property Rights.

**17. An industrial Visit** to the Sant Mahavir Jain Trust, Common Facility Centre (Carpet & Home Furnishing Cluster) in village Dharodi, Narwana (Jind) registered under Khadi and Village Industries and Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME), Government of India was organized on 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2024. Thirty-three students took part in the industrial visit, gaining insights into the handloom industry from raw material processing to finished products, quality control, marketing strategies, and product exports.

**18. Thirty-Two hours Value Added Course (VAC)** on “**Basic IT Tools**” was also conduct from 8<sup>th</sup> September, 2023 to 18<sup>th</sup> October 2023. The objective of this course was to provide overview of IT tools used in day-to- day use of computer and data base operations. Thirty-seven students successfully completed this course.



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
