**[ Yoga, Physical Fitness, Health and Hygiene]**


A One day workshop on life skills, yoga, physical fitness, health and hygiene was conducted jointly by the English, Hindi and Sanskrit department on 19 May 2023. The workshop was anchored by Dr Geeta Gupta. New Education Policy gives great importance to life skills as they are essential for inculcating discipline and confidence among students. On this topic, Dr Alka Dunputh- Head language Resource Centre, Mahatma Gandhi Institute, Mauritius, conducted the workshop. Dr Alka Dhanputh said that life skills play an important part in managing our life and time. Yoga not only makes us fit but it also relaxes our mind and enables us to connect with the divine within. She also talked about cleanliness and hygiene. Cleanliness is next to Godliness. She also talked about *pancha koshas* and their importance. About 153 teachers and students attended the conference.
