Event: 16-day Traditional Haryanvi Folk Handicraft Workshop
5th August, 2024 to 20th August, 2024

A 16-day Traditional Haryanvi Folk Handicraft workshop was organized under the joint aegis of the Department of Home Science, Fine Art Club of Hindu Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Jind and Haryana Kala Parishad, Hisar Mandal. The workshop ran from August 5, 2024 to August 20, 2024. The workshop started with the lighting of the lamp by the principal of the college, Dr. Poonam Mor. The main objective of organizing this workshop was to bring back the ancient folk handicraft of Haryana which was on the verge of extinction among the youth. The instructor of this workshop was Mr. Gautam Sathyaraj. Mr. Gautam Sathyaraj said that if the youth increase their expertise in art and study art with continuous dedication, then employment opportunities also start coming up. Especially women get employment sitting at home. In order to preserve the culture and spread of art of Haryana, it is necessary that we give handicraft training to young students. In the workshop, he trained the students about the fading folk handicraft of Haryana, in which he taught the students how to make sparklers, cloth parrots, bijna, binderwal, rangoli, sewing of torans and parrots, making cloth dolls, clay modeling, decorating the fabric made of clothes with pearls and laces. He taught the students to make different parts of Sanjhi out of clay. He also trained the students in painting and poster making. On this occasion, Principal Dr. Poonam Mor encouraged all the students and gave the message of women's self-employment and preservation of culture. Mrs. Arti Saini, In-charge of the Department of Home Science thanked Mr. Gautam Sathyaraj Ji and his other colleagues. She assured to organize such type of workshops of Haryanvi folk handicraft in future also. She also thanked the teachers of the Department of Home Science, Mrs. Tanu Rani, Mrs. Anu Rani and Mrs. Raman Kumari, In-charge of the Fine Art Club for successfully organising the workshop.
