### **Entrepreneurship Development club :-**

The Red Cross Cell of our college is affiliated to the Indian Red Cross Society, Chandigarh. The cell of our college provides books, woolen clothes and fee concession to poor and Differently abled students various activities are organized by the cell:

1. In the beginning of the session meeting was held and students were enrolled.
2. On 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2022, Doctor's day was celebrated and poster making competition was organized. In this competition students expressed their respect towards the doctors through their posters.
3. On 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2022, 'Youth Red Cross Cell' under the joint aegis of 'Inner Wheel Club' organized H.B. checkup camp in which about 70 girl students and staff members checked their H.B.
4. In the month of January sweaters were distributed to economically challenged girl students.
5. Three girl students of our college participated in the five day Youth Red Cross Camp organized by CRSU, Jind on 20-24 February, 2023.
6. On May, 2023, a health awareness camp was organized under the joint aegis of the college's 'Youth Red Cross Cell' and Primary Health Centre Dhathrath. In this camp Dr. Ashok Mehta emphasized on increasing the amount of protein rich diet, green leafy vegetables and fiber. They also advised to avoid smoking and alcohol consumption.

5. **Inter University Level Youth Festival:** After the victory of Zonal & Inter Zonal Youth Festival our some efficient students got opportunity to represent the CRSU in Inter University Youth Festival which was organized by M.M. University, Mulana.
6. **Republic Day:** 26<sup>th</sup> January was celebrated as Republic day in college premises. Our management members, staff members (teaching/non-teaching)

### **N.S.S. REPORT:-**

The National Service Scheme unit is continuously striving for the personality development of the youth power of the nation. Youth program for the personality development of the youth power of the nation is an active program run by the Ministry of Sports and Government of India.
