<u>Title</u>: Sowing Sustainability: Green Practices at H.K.M.V. Jind

<u>Context:</u> In alignment with environmental consciousness and a commitment to sustainable living, H.K.M.V Jind has instituted a "Sowing Sustainability" program incorporated various green practices to reduce the college's ecological footprint and install eco-friendly habits among students and staff.

Objectives: The objectives of implementing green practices are –

- 1. Environmental Conservation: By reducing ecological impact of the college's activities.

The Practices:

- 1. The college has developed beautiful campus with many small and large lawns.
- 2. The college has a herbal garden.
- 3. The college has nursery maintenance by students of NCC.
- 4. Borewell recharge pits have been constructed on the college campus for harvesting the rain water.
- 5. Solar power panel of 12 KW has been installed.
- 6. LED bulbs are installed in the college buildings to save the electricity.
- 7. Different coloured dust bins are being used for segregation of waste.
- 8. Circulars to ban use of polythene and plastics have been issued.
- 9. Green Audit and Energy Audit have been performed by external agencies.
- 10. MOU with Go Green Earth NGO has been done to make campus plastic free.

- 11. Workshop on water conservation and best out of waste were conducted for students and people of village Khokhri.
- 12. Environmental promotional activities outside the campus were conducted.
- 13. Extension lectures on environmental friendly practices were conducted.
- 14. Environmental studies is compulsory part of B.A., B.Sc. and B.Com's curriculum.

Evidence of Success

- 1. The adoption of green practices has resulted in measurable improvements in waste reduction energy conservation and overall environmental awareness.
- 2. The college now boost of lush green lawns.
- 3. Energy Audit and cream audit have been done.
- 4. Recommendations of Greenland energy audit will be implemented from the next session.
- 5. The institution is in process of becoming a plastic free campus.
- 6. Eco club has been established.
- 7. Herbal Park boasts of 50 different types of herbal trees and shrubs.

Problems encountered and resources required

It is difficult to implement ban on use of Polythene and plastics as they are easy to use and cheap as compared to their substitutes. Consistent mentoring and motivation are required to implement green practices. Financial resources are required for many equipment for getting green practices implemented.
