Department of Music Vocal

1. Teacher's Day Celebration (5th September, 2025)

On 5th September, 2025-26, Teacher's Day was celebrated by Music Vocal Department of Hindu Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Jind. Students of B. A. I, II, III participated in this event. The teachings of Chanakya Neeti were discussed in this programme with Audio/Video clips of these types. The main motive of this event was focusing on how a successful teacher guides his/her discipline and leads them to great heights.

2. 15 Days Folk Dance Workshop (19th September to 8th October, 2025)

A 15 days folk dance workshop was organised under the joint aegis of the Music Vocal Department & Cultural Department of Hindu Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Jind in which 25 girls students participated. This program was sponsored by the Haryana Kala Parishad and the Department of Arts & Culture, Chandigarh. In this workshop the college students learned various styles of Haryanvi Folk Dance such as Jhumar, Ghumar, Phaag, Khodiya, Thaal Nach etc. Mr. Ankit and Mrs. Ritu were the trainers of this training program, who taught the students to different forms of folk dance in detail.

3. Talent Show (Singing Event) on 6th October, 2025

A Talent Hunt program of singing events organised by Music Vocal Department under the directions of DYCA, CRSU, Jind. The winner students got cash prize of Rs. 400 (1st), Rs. 300 (2nd) and Rs. 200 (3rd) by the DYCA, CRSU, Jind in their respective accounts.

4. One Day Workshop & Diya Making Competition on 17th October, 2025

On the occasion of Diwali celebrations, the Music Vocal Department and Cultural Department of Hindu Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Jind organized a one-day workshop on Art and Craft and Diya Making Competition. During the event the students decorated beautiful diyas. Around 45 girls participated in this event. Jyoti, Sangeeta and Jyoti respectively securing the 1st, 2nd, & 3rd positions. Mrs. Megha Kataria who is an expert in Art & Craft, was the Resource Person and also played the role of the judge.

5. An Extension Lecture (18th October, 2025)

On 18th October, 2025 an extension lecture was organised by the Music Vocal Department on the topic '*Khayal Gayaki ka Swaroop*'. The Keynote Speaker for the event was Dr. Krishan Kumar, Assistant Professor of Music Vocal in Music Department of CRSU, Jind. While Dr. Krishan explaining the nature of Khyal Gayaki, he elaborated the forms of Raag such as Vilambit Khayal, Alaap, Taan & Tarana to the students very effectively. He did not limit his lecture to the theory alone but practically explained the terms to the students by singing various compositions. Total 17 girls attended this lecture.

6. Lohri Celebration (13th January, 2026)

On dated 13th January, 2026 the Music Vocal Department organised a Lohari Celebration for students and staff members with the objective of preserving and promoting our rich folk traditions. The purpose of event was to connect everyone with Punjabi folk culture through music, dance and traditional rituals. It also served as a cultural break that strengthened the bond between teachers and students.

7. One Day Workshop

A one-day workshop on the topic '*Gharana Paddhti in Music Teaching*' was organised by the Music Vocal Department. The renowned vocalist PT. Naresh Malhotra of Indore Gharana, who is retired Assistant Director of AIR from New Delhi, was the Resource Person for the event. He discussed the various Gharana systems of Indian Classical Music in detail, covering both gayan gharana and Vadan Gharanas. The workshop provided students with a comprehensive understanding of the historical, cultural and pedagogical importance of the Gharana Tradition.
