1. 15 Days Folk Dance Workshop (19th September to 8th October, 2025)

A 15 days folk dance workshop was organised under the joint aegis of the Music Vocal Department & Cultural Department of Hindu Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Jind in which 25 girls students participated.
