




Report of the Event

Hindu Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Jind organized a Cleanliness Drive in its adopted village Haibatpur on 15th April, 2026. This event was a joint effort by the NSS unit and the NCC wing. The main focus of this drive was the village 'Shiv Temple'. The college Principal Dr. Poonam Mor flagged off the volunteers and cadets for village cleanliness activity under the supervision of NSS Programme Officer Mrs. Kranti and NCC CTO Mrs. Anju.

During the drive, the students thoroughly cleaned the Shiv Temple premises and the surrounding areas. Principal Dr. Poonam Mor encouraged the students, stating that such initiatives are essential for their overall personality development. By focusing on the Shiv Temple, the students not only improved the cleanliness of the village but also showed respect for local cultural and religious heritage. 65 students participated enthusiastically in this cleanliness drive.
