Event: 'Tiranga Yatra & Selfie with Tiranga' to celebrate 'Har
Ghar Tiranga Abhiyan'

On August 14-15, 2025, Hindu Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Jind, organized a Tiranga Yatra to celebrate 'Har Ghar Tiranga Abhiyan' through its NCC wing and NSS unit. The event was presided over by the college principal, Dr. Poonam Mor, and managed by NCC In-charge Mrs. Anju and NSS Program Officer Mrs. Kranti.
