**Event: Essay Writing Competition on the occasion of 'World  
Human Rights Day'  
10<sup>th</sup> December, 2025**

On the occasion of World Human Rights Day, an essay writing competition was organized on 10<sup>th</sup> December 2025 by the NSS Unit and the Department of Political Science of Hindu Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Jind. The topic of the essay was "Human Rights in a Changing India: Issues and Challenges." On this occasion, the Principal of the college, Dr. Poonam Mor, addressed the students and explained that human rights are the basic rights which every person gets merely by being human, such as the right to equality, freedom of expression, right to education and the right to live with dignity. She further stated that World Human Rights Day is celebrated to commemorate the Universal Declaration of Human Rights by the United Nations and that in today's changing India, awareness of human rights, their protection, and respect for the rights of others is extremely relevant.

The essay writing competition was efficiently conducted by NSS Programme Officer Mrs. Kranti and the Incharge of the Department of Political Science, Mrs. Neelam. The students wrote meaningful and reflective essays on the topic, in which they seriously deliberated on the contemporary issues and challenges related to human rights in a changing India. The role of the judging panel was fulfilled by Mrs. Anju, Assistant Professor in the Department of Mathematics, and Dr. Priyanka Sahni, Assistant Professor in the Department of Economics. In the competition, the first position was secured by Sajida of class B.A 3rd Year, the second position was secured by Manula Jain of class BCA 2nd Year, and the third position was secured by Tannu of class B.A. 3rd Year. Principal Dr. Poonam Mor presented prizes to the winners and extended her congratulations and best wishes for their bright future.

Total 23 students participated in this activity. At the end of the programme, the volunteers shared that through this event they gained a deeper understanding of the basic concept of human rights, constitutional provisions, and the importance of citizens' duties. They also realized that the role of youth is extremely important in protecting the rights of the weaker and marginalized sections of society. The students resolved that they would not only remain aware of their own rights but would also make active efforts for the protection and respect of the rights of others.
