Event: Celebration of World Earth Day
22nd April, 2026

In observance of World Earth Day, Hindu Kanya Mahavidyalaya organized a series of eco-friendly initiatives under the joint auspices of the National Service Scheme (NSS) unit and the Eco Club. The event featured a diverse range of activities, including a formal pledge ceremony, a comprehensive plantation drive, the installation of water bowls (secure) for birds, and a public awareness rally throughout the city. The proceedings commenced with a collective oath dedicated to the preservation and conservation of the Earth. Under the guidance of Principal Dr. Punam Mor, the students and faculty members formally committed to protecting nature and preventing environmental degradation.
