Event: N.S.S. Volunteers Participated in Haryana State N.S.S.
Adventure Camp
25th June to 5th July, 2026

Two N.S.S. volunteers from Hindu Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Jind participated in a ten-day Adventure Camp organized by the Haryana State N.S.S., Panchkula, held at the Solang Skiing Centre, Manali. The camp was conducted from 25th June to 5th July, 2026 and convened a total of one hundred volunteers from various institutions across Haryana.

Ms Payal, from B. A. 1st year and Ms Radhika, from B. C. A. 1st year were officially selected by the college to represent the institution at this camp. During the camp, both participants underwent structured practical training in a variety of adventure and survival activities, including rock climbing, trekking, river crossing and rappelling.

Beyond physical pursuits, the volunteers attended thematic sessions on mountainous hazards, essential protocols for the Himalayan region and eco-conservation strategies for safeguarding fragile mountain ecosystems. They also received practical instruction in rucksack packing, tent pitching and improvised stretcher fabrication competencies that are integral to high-altitude emergency response and disaster preparedness.

Upon the successful completion of the camp, Principal of the college Dr. Poonam Mor and N.S.S. Programme Officer Mrs. Kranti congratulated the participants. Dr. Mor emphasized that engagement in college-level programmes of this nature is instrumental in cultivating holistic development. She asserted that such experiences nurture physical resilience, self-reliance and leadership acumen, thereby furnishing students with a futuristic outlook to navigate complex challenges with confidence and determination.

This Adventure Camp proved to be a transformative endeavour, equipping the volunteers with indispensable life skills.
