Report of Road Safety Club


(Session:2023-24)

1.) On 13 October, 2023, a road safety quiz was organized by the Road Safety Club of Hindu Kanya Mahavidyalaya Jind as per the letter sent by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarters Jind. The program was presided over by the college principal Dr. Poonam Mor. About 110 girl students of the college participated in this quiz. The college principal said that quiz competitions should be held for road safety so that road safety awareness increases among the girl students. The girl students also participated in the program with great enthusiasm.

We pledge that we will do our best to promote road safety. Today we pledge: -


- Will always wear a helmet while driving a two-wheeler.

4.) On 27th January 2024, under the Road Safety Month, Road Safety Club made the college girls aware about the importance of road safety through PPT.



5.) Under the Road Safety Month on 29th January 2024, Road Safety Club put up road sign pamphlets on all the display boards of the college to make the college students aware about the importance of road safety, as in view of the increasing cases of road accidents, it has become the need of the hour to make the youth aware about how to take care of others and stay safe while driving.





6.) On 06 February 2024, a one-day awareness program was organized in the seminar hall under the joint aegis of Road Safety Club and Seva Trust UK (India) and InDepth Vision Foundation. The program was inaugurated under the chairmanship of Principal Madam Dr. Poonam Mor. The coordinator of this program, Dr. Rashmi Malik (Incharge, Road Safety Club) said that the keynote speaker in this program was Mr. Suresh Kumar, Coordinator, Traffic Police and his topic was "Awareness for Road Safety". 102 girl students participated in this program. Addressing the girl students in his speech, Mr. Suresh Kumar mainly emphasized on the importance of helmet, controlled speed of vehicle on the road, vehicle insurance and driving license. He told that our life is precious and it is the responsibility of all of us to protect it. While walking on the road, we should take care of the safety of others along with ourselves. Seva Trust U. participated in the program. K. (India) and Jind District Coordinator of InDepth Vision Foundation Anil Ghanghas were also present. At the end of the program, Anil Ghanghas distributed packets of Real Juice to the students as refreshment. On this occasion, Road Safety Club Co-convenor Dr. Anshu and all the professors of the History Department were present. At the end of the successful conduct of the program, the college principal addressed the students and congratulated Dr. Rashmi Malik and also thanked the keynote speaker Suresh Kumar and Anil Ghanghas from the bottom of her heart for taking out their precious time and coming to the college and cooperating.





7.) On 07 February 2024, the Road Safety Club of Hindu Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Jind, under the joint aegis of the Government College, successfully organized a program for awareness of road safety rules in the premises of the college. This program was organized under the "Memorandum of Understanding" between the two colleges. The program was inaugurated under the chairmanship of Principal Madam Dr. Poonam Mor. The team of Dr. Pankaj Batra, Mrs. Poonam and Mr. Gurdeep, the director and Road Safety Club in-charge of this program organized by the Government College, awakened the children through street plays and mono acting for road safety. It was told through the drama that even a little carelessness while walking on the road can be fatal for our life. This program was conducted by Dr. Anshu, co-convener of the Road Safety Club. After the successful conduct of the program, Dr. Anshu thanked Dr. Pankaj Batra and Mrs. Poonam, Mr. Gurdeep ji from the Government College from the

bottom of her heart for taking out their valuable time and congratulated the entire team of her college for their efforts. In the end, the children were also administered the oath of road safety rules. On this occasion, Mrs. Soni, Rekha, Nisha and Kumari Geeta were present.





8.) On 13 February 2024, a door-to-door campaign was organized by the Road Safety Club and the Department of History in Khokhari village under the Road Safety Month Awareness Campaign to make the villagers aware about the benefits of using helmets and precautions for road safety. This program was inaugurated by the Principal of the college, Dr. Poonam Mor. The coordinator of the program, Dr. Rashmi Malik (Incharge Road Safety Club, Head of History Department), with the help of Kumari Geeta (History Professor) and 50 students of the college, went door to door for road safety in Khokhari village and told the villagers about the main precautions to be taken while driving and made people aware of the benefits of helmet, seat belt, driving at low speed etc. The elders of the village praised this effort made by the college.





9.) An extension lecture on the topic "Drug Abuse, Road Safety and Cyber Crime" was organized on 21st March 2024 under the joint aegis of Road Safety Club and Red Ribbon Club. The program was organized under the leadership of Dr. Poonam Kajal, Principal of the college and was conducted by Dr. Anshu Sailpar, Red Ribbon Club Incharge and Road Safety Club member. Around 60 students attended the extension lecture. All the guest speakers were from Haryana Police Department, working as a team of ADGP, Hisar. First of all, touching upon very relevant issues, Mr. Sajan Kumar, Public Relations Officer, (PRO) Police Department, Hisar addressed the college students. He made our girl students aware about women safety and drug abuse. He said that girls should be aware of the women helpline number 112, where they can register their complaints at any time. He also talked about the evils of smoking and urged our girl students to make people aware about these evils as much as possible. He said that hookah is the gateway to all kinds of drugs. After the talk by Shri Sajjan Kumar, Shri Naresh Kumar, Sub-Inspector, Police Department, Jind addressed the students on road safety. He stressed on the importance of wearing helmets. He told the students that careless driving can be fatal for anyone, so he urged the students to drive safely. In the end, Mr. Amit Kumar, ASI, Cyber Crime Cell, Police Department, Jind addressed the students and made them aware about the ten types of online fraud prevalent nowadays. He cautioned the students not to share their OTP with anyone. He requested the college administration to organize such awareness programs on a large scale in the college campus, so that maximum number of students can benefit from such programs. Dr. Anshu thanked all the speakers and promised to organize such awareness programs.
