**Event: Two Days Program for Making Voter Card**  
**29<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2025**

On 29<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2025 a two days program was successfully organized in the premises of Hindu Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Jind under the Electoral Literacy Club. The objective of this programme was to make the students aware of the process of making Voter Identity Cards and to provide them with the necessary information regarding the same. The entire programme was coordinated by Dr. Sushma Garg, Convener of the Electoral Literacy Club, while Mr. Narayan Singh played an important role as Co-convener. The programme was presided over by the Principal of the college, Dr. Poonam Mor, who explained to the students the significance of the Voter Identity Card. During the programme, detailed information was provided by Mr. Narayan Singh to all students of age 18 years and above who had not yet made their Voter Identity Card. He explained the process of applying for the card, the required documents and the procedure of application. Students were also made aware of the guidelines issued by the Election Commission. On this occasion, Programme Convener Dr. Sushma Garg addressed the students and said, “Voting is not only a fundamental right of every citizen but also a duty. For the strengthening of democracy, it is essential that every eligible citizen’s name is included in the voter list and that they cast their vote”. She motivated the students to make their own Voter ID Cards and also encouraged others to do the same. The programme concluded with a vote of thanks. This initiative instilled a new sense of awareness and enthusiasm among the students regarding their democratic rights and duties.
