- Industrial Visit (15 Oct. 2022)

An Industrial visit to Lakshay Milk Plant was organised to provide practical knowledge of production process in manufacturing units. The students got informative knowledge from visit. It was a great experience for them. 38 students and 3 lectures took participation in it.

- Quiz Competition at College Level (18 Oct. 2022)

This competition was organised on 18 October 2022. Other departments also participated in it. There were 7 teams (A to G) which took participation in it. There were team of three students one student from B.com, one from B.A. and one from B.Sc. - Organisation of One Day Workshop on Best Out of Waste (26<sup>th</sup> May 2023)  
Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC) and Commerce Department of Jointly Organized a Workshop on "Best Out of Waste" for Women of Khokhri Village On 26th May, 2023. The main objective of this workshop was to build the spirit of self-employment among the women by using the waste material available at home so that they could generate employment for themselves. They shared the process of making wall hangings by using old bangles and making flowers by using old clothes with the women of the village.
