

Holistic development of students

Holistic development of students is top priority of college and management. Being a women college, it was ambition of the founders of the college to mould young girls into a disciplined, upright and empowered women of the modern times.

Our students perform excellently in academics, extra curricular activities and sports. In the session 2019-2020 in M.Sc. Mathematics, 9 students got place in the top 10 positions of the University. In M.A. History- 12 students got place in the top 10 positions in the University. Extra curricular activities are conducted by all the departments of the college. These activities include physical activities, Lit. activities, social activities, aesthetic, cultural activities, craft activities and patriotic activities. The subject societies have president, vice-president and secretary as their office bearers. Along with subject societies, various cells of the college- NSS, Sports, Legal Literacy Cell, Red-Cross, Women Cell, Alumni Association, Election Voters Awareness Cell and Entrepreneurship Development Club conduct activities.

It is a matter of great pride for us that in Inter Zonal festival conducted from 13th to 15th Feb, 2019, our college participated in 27 genres and secured first position in 9 genres and second in 5 genres. The team of Haryanvi group dance of our college stood first in State level competition 'Dishyaen' and won cash prize of Rs. 21000/-. In Inter University competition 'Spandan' organized by Central University

Mahendargarh, our college won second position in Haryanvi Group dance, Mehendi competition, Light vocal Indian and classical dance.

The team of Haryanvi group dance also gave its presentation on Doordarshan on the occasion of Holi festival as a part of contingent of CRSU. It was telecast on 10th March, 2019 on 9:00 A.M and 4:00 P.M respectively.

During lock down many webinar and online competitions were organised for both students and staff. A national level musical contest (online) was held in which 23 competitors participated from 8 zones.

An International level online webinar was also held jointly by English department and Hindi department of the college on 28th June, 2020. Dr. Alka Dhunputh, Creative Head of the Department of creative writings and publications of Mahatma Gandhi International University Mauritius, was one of the eminent speakers. Computer-Science department was also conducted a National level online quiz on 'Covid-19 Awareness'. A National Level Quiz in Economics was also held. National Nutrition week from (1-7 Sept., 2019) was celebrated during Lock down. Lecturers in Home Science trained students in mask making through video-tutorials and also distributed masks in their neighbourhood. Various competitions were also conducted by Home-Science department online for faculty and students - such as Slogan writing, Poster-Making, Rangoli-Making and online cooking competition. English and

Hindi department also conducted a webinar for final year students to address their problems during lockdown.

In sports students secured 24 positions at district level and 3 positions at state level 3 girls participated at All India level. Inculcating moral values and disciplines goes along with extracurricular activities. Maximum number of girls come to college from rural areas and are from the poor families. The parents of the girls are unable to give them time to attend to their emotional needs and guide them as they are too busy in eking out a living. Girls require a lot support and guidance and this lack is fulfilled by teachers of our college who act as their mentors, guides and family member. Most of the girls attach themselves to their teachers and regularly go to them for guidance. Girls are guided by the teachers in maintaining hygiene, sanitation and other aspects of life. Girls get very agreeable and pleasant environment in the college campus and they feel at home in the college campus. When the girls come to college, they have very low confidence level but with passage of the time, they learn to express themselves and indulge in various extra-curricular activities of the college. The protection and warmth of the college nurtures in them a feeling of security. Thus, the college has a strong network of students who remain connected to the Alma Mater ever after leaving the college. In this age of increasing materialism, fashioning good human beings who are upright and morally sturdy is a great accomplishment. Our students who get admission in other institutions for higher studies are always appreciated for their initiative, discipline and hard work.
