
Hindu Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Jind Students Satisfaction Survey 2023-24

1. How do you rate the course information provided by college through college website and rule book?





2. Rate overall quality of learning experience in the college.




3. Are you satisfied with the methods and quality of curriculum delivery ? $_{\rm 357\,responses}$




4. Does teacher Use Audio/Visual aids/ to promote ICT based learning? 357 responses




5. Does the teacher come fully prepared for the class? 357 responses



6. Does the Teacher encourage the participation and discussion in the class? $_{\rm 357\,responses}$




7. Does the teacher discuss career options with you? 357 responses




8. Does the Teacher cover the whole of the prescribed syllabus?







9. Are there sufficient numbers of books of your subjects in the library ? $_{\rm 357\,responses}$




10. Are there sufficient cultural/sports facilities available in the college? 357 responses

Findings:

- A significant majority of students expressed satisfaction with the course information provided on the college website and in the rule book, with a combined 83.7% rating it as good or excellent, indicating the information resources are well-received.
- ➤ The majority of students, approximately 85%, rated the overall quality of their learning experience as either good or excellent, highlighting a generally positive perception of the college's educational environment.
- A substantial proportion of students reported satisfaction with the methods and quality of curriculum delivery, with 55.5% rating it as good and 26.9% rating it as excellent, suggesting a need to maintain and potentially enhance current pedagogical approaches.
- ➤ Over 75% of students expressed satisfaction with the use of ICT in learning, indicating that the integration of technology in the classroom is effective and appreciated.
- An overwhelming majority of students, exceeding 90%, positively acknowledged their teachers' preparedness for class, with responses of good and excellent, demonstrating a strong commitment to instruction.
- ➤ A substantial majority of students, exceeding 90%, rated teachers as good or excellent in their role of encouraging student participation, underscoring the effectiveness of instructors in fostering an engaging learning environment.
- A considerable percentage of students, 82.9%, rated the teachers' efforts in discussing career options as good or excellent, indicating the importance of career guidance to students.
- ➤ Over 90% of students rate that the prescribed syllabus is being covered adequately, with ratings of good and excellent, suggesting effective curriculum management and delivery.
- ➤ A significant proportion of students, 79%, rated the sufficiency of subject-related books in the library as good or excellent, suggesting that library resources align well with academic needs.
- ➤ the majority of students, 91.9%, believe that the college provides sufficient cultural and sports facilities, indicating a positive perception of extracurricular offerings.
- A substantial majority of students, 86.8%, agreed that their grievances were addressed in a timely manner, highlighting the effectiveness of the college's support system.
- > 88.5% of students would recommend the program to others, indicating a strong endorsement and overall satisfaction with their educational experience.

Constructive suggestions were provided by students, which will inform future actions and improvements to enhance the overall student experience.

Action Taken:

- > Students reported that the washrooms were dirty. The housekeeping staff were informed and instructed to clean the washrooms daily. Dustbins have also been placed in the washrooms for better hygiene.
- ➤ NCC (National Cadet Corps) has been introduced from the academic session 2023-24 for the benefit of students.
- ➤ Teachers have been asked to deliver the curriculum in a lucid manner and plan their lectures according to the topics. Efforts are being made to ensure that the subject matter is clearly understood by the students.
- ➤ Various personality development and career development programs have been introduced in the college during the session.
- > Several value-added courses were also conducted during the academic session to enhance students' skills and knowledge.
